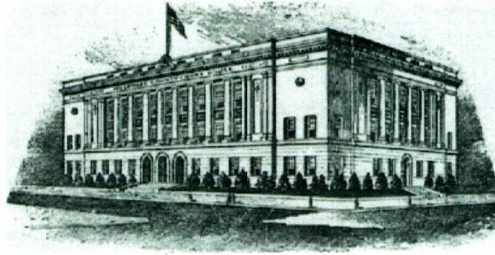



PETITION

WE THE PEOPLE the undersigned Petitioner(s) and respectfully request that the Muskogee County Board of County Commissioners (“the Board”) close and vacate a portion of the county roadway known as E 213th St S, located in Muskogee County, Oklahoma, and in support thereof state the following:

Description of Roadway

The roadway requested for closure is a portion of E 213th St S, beginning at 4741 E 213TH ST S and ending at 5250 E 213th ST S. A map or legal description may be provided upon request or submitted as an exhibit.

Ownership and Direct Impact

Petitioner(s) own and lease property directly adjoining the portion of roadway described above and are directly affected by the conditions and activities occurring thereon.

Basis for Request — Public Safety and Property Protection

The portion of E 213th St S at issue has become a repeated and ongoing site of criminal and unsafe activity, including but not limited to:

Theft of property occurring along and adjacent to the roadway;

Vandalism to private property and road-adjacent structures;

Trespassing onto petitioner's land and neighboring parcels;

Harassment and threatening actions towards property owners by individuals using the roadway for unauthorized purposes;

Dumping and burning of stolen vehicles;

General public safety concerns, including suspicious activity, loitering, and unauthorized vehicle or foot traffic.

These activities have created an unsafe environment for residents, visitors, and property owners and continue despite repeated attempts at mitigation.

Failure of Alternative Remedies

Petitioner(s) have made reasonable efforts to deter the illegal activity, including contacting law enforcement, improving lighting, posting signage, and monitoring the area.

Despite these efforts, illegal and hazardous behavior persists.

Public Interest Considerations

The portion of roadway requested for closure:

Is not needed for regular public use,

Does not provide essential access to any occupied dwelling or business, and

Its closure will not impair emergency vehicle access, agricultural access, or county services.

Closing this segment of E 213th St S would enhance safety, reduce crime, protect property, and serve the best interests of the community.
