Sooner Emergency Service, Inc. was contacted by Muskogee County 911 and was advised of an unknown chemical spill on 53RD Street, a ¼ mile East of 74th Street in Muskogee. Sooner Emergency Service, Inc. was requested to conduct an emergency response to the spill scene and conduct cleanup procedures as required. Appropriate equipment and personnel were dispatched to the scene to properly conduct the cleanup procedures.

Upon arrival Sooner met with the fire department and it was determined that someone lost a barrel of kerosene causing a slick spot on the roadway.

The contaminated area was covered immediately with Safe Step absorbent to clean, solidify and contain the hydrocarbons. The approximate size of the spill area was 30 ft long x 4 ft wide. The spill was also in the ditch along the roadway and techs placed absorbent booms on both ends of the spill along with absorbent pads to prevent further migration. Micro Blaze was applied to the ditch as well. A vac truck was used to vacuum the kerosene from the top of the water in the ditch. Approximately 1,000 gallons of the kerosene mixture were recovered. Absorbent booms were left in place until the next rainfall.

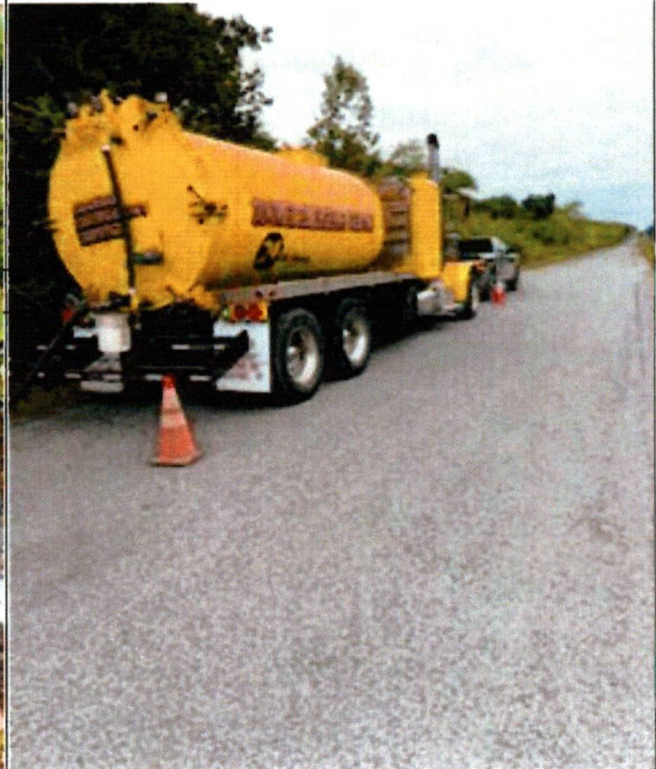

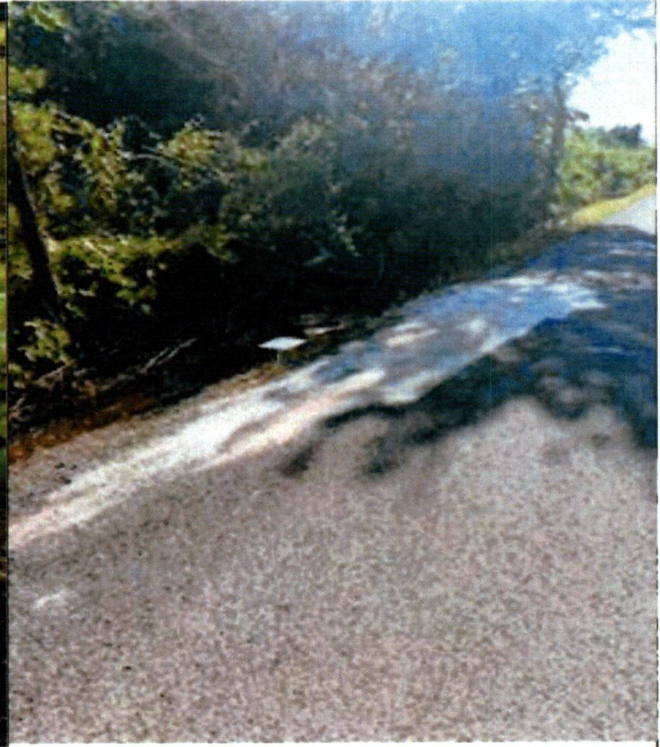
