RESOLUTION NO. 2025-04

SUBJECT: Sheriff's Office Funding Assistance Grant

WHEREAS, 19 OS § 339 charges the Board of County Commissioners with general financial supervision of county government finances;

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Sherriff's Office Funding Assistance Grant Program Act of 2024 (74 OS § 20k-1A *et seq.*) provides granting funding to the Muskogee County Sheriff's Office to better enable it to provide professional law enforcement services.

WHEREAS, the Muskogee County Sheriff's Office is a qualified grant receipt under the Oklahoma Sherriff's Office Funding Assistance Grant Program Act of 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MUSKOGEE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. POLICY. The Muskogee County Sheriff's Office is authorized and directed to apply to the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office for funding under the Oklahoma Sherriff's Office Funding Assistance Grant Program Act of 2024 for fiscal year 2026. All grant proceeds received by the county government pursuant to the Oklahoma Sherriff's Office Funding Assistance Grant Program Act of 2024 shall:

- (1) be separately accounted for as required by the guidelines established by the Oklahoma State Auditor and Inspector's Office (Fund #1574); and
- (2) be spent only for the lawful operations of the Muskogee County Sheriff's Office as required by the guidelines established by the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office, provided such proceeds shall not be used for the payment of salaries.

SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION. All departments, officers, and employees of the county government shall take all appropriate measures within their authority to implement this

resolution. Nothing in this resolution shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect the authority granted by law to a county department or officer. This resolution shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations. This resolution is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the county, its departments, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All other resolutions and parts of other resolutions inconsistent or conflicting with any part of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision, paragraph, word, section of article of this resolution is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon execution and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.
