4. Firm prices will be F.O.B. destination.
5. Purchases by MUSKOGEE County, Oklahoma, are not subject to state or federal taxes.
6. This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on 2/27, 202³ at 9:30 am at a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, in their meeting room. Any bids received after the scheduled time for closing will be returned unopened.

Bid packets must be in a sealed envelope or box clearly labeled "SEALED BID – STARVILLA CREEK" on the outside packaging.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, or Cashier's Check upon any solvent Bank or Trust Company, payable without reserve to the Muskogee County, Oklahoma, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. Bid security of the two low bidders will be retained until approval of contract and execution of satisfactory bonds by the successful bidder, or until other disposition on the bids is made. BIDDER must obtain the plans and specifications from the Eastern Oklahoma Circuit Engineering District and must be on the "plan holders list" in order to receive any addendums or additional information prior to final submittal.

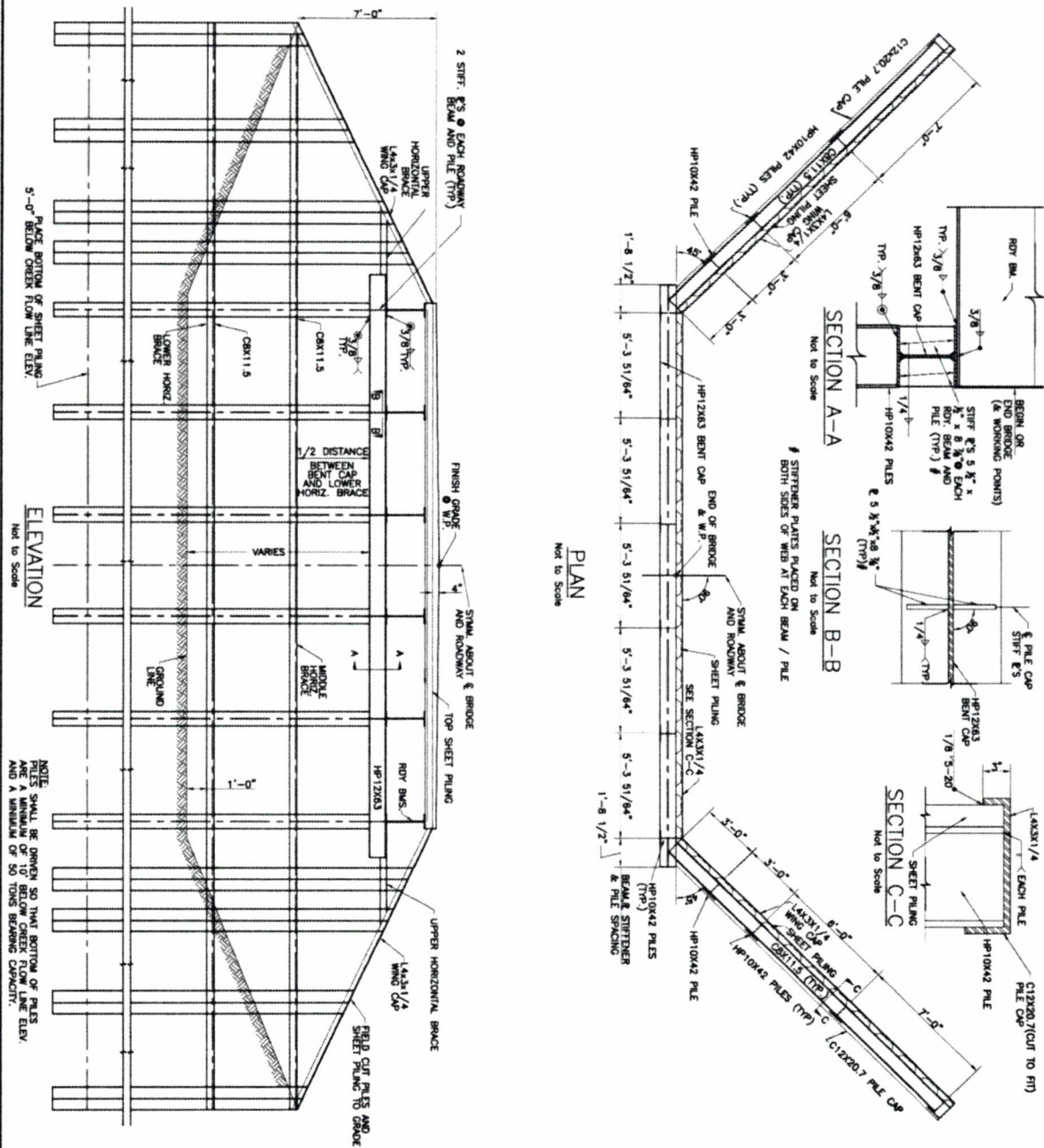

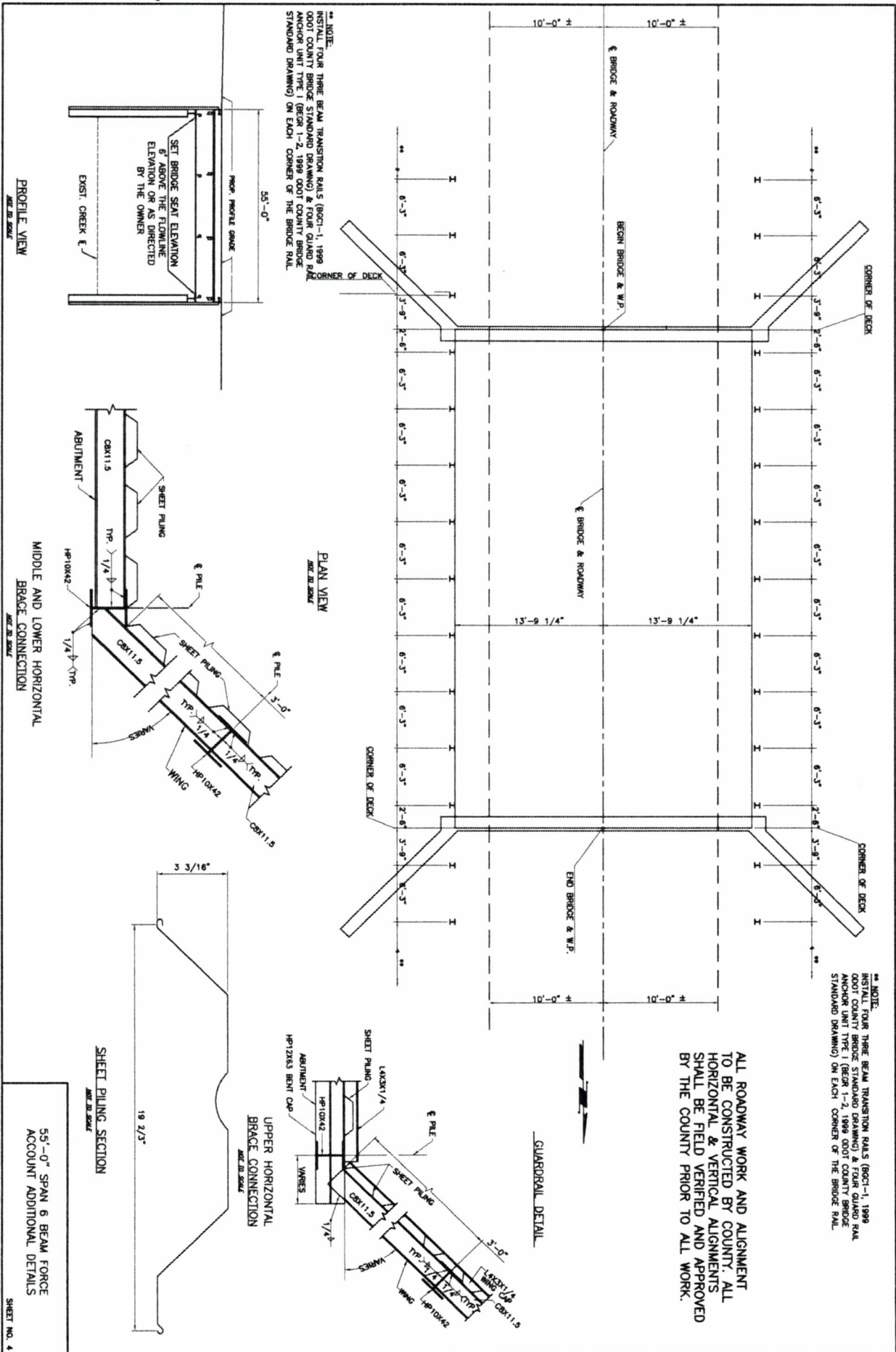


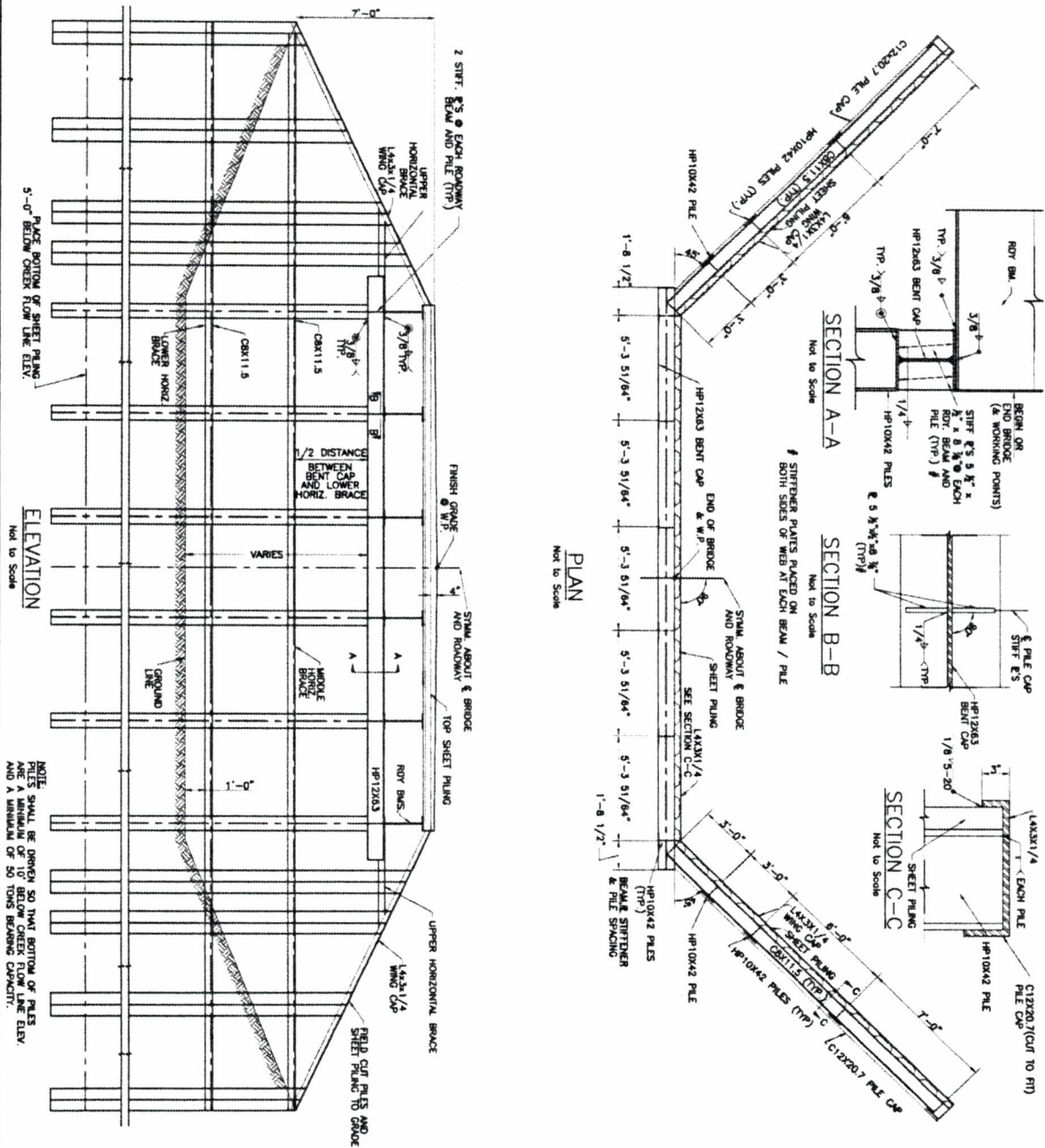
