VENDOR MUST PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN HIS/HER OWN EQUIPMENT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: MOWER, WEEDEATER, SPRAYERS, CHEMICALS, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, FUEL, PARTS, ETC.

CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH BID

MOWING: (To be bid by square foot)

County owned property must be maintained boundary to boundary. Finished length minimum of two (2) inches and maximum of four (4) inches and includes, but is not limited to:

- Mowing grass.
- Clearing brush and other growth, including, but not limited to: brush, sticks, small tree limbs, leaf accumulations, poison sumac, poison ivy, poison oak, etc.
- Filling holes.

Vendor must provide a license with the bid for use or distribution of chemicals if utilizing chemicals to spray poisonous growth. If sub-contracting the use of chemicals on poisonous growth, a license for the sub-contractor must be submitted with the bid. All chemicals and equipment used for the disbursement thereof must be provided and maintained by the vendor or sub-contractor.

SECURING/BOARDING UP STRUCTURES: (Hourly bid)

County owned property/structures that creates a health or safety hazard must be secured to limit access to include, but is not limited to:

- Boarding up windows, doors, and any other entries.
- Boarding up/tarping roofs.
- Padlocking doors, garage doors, etc.

Vendor must provide and maintain proper equipment and provide any and all material and supplies.

DEBRIS REMOVAL: (Hourly bid)

Removal of debris from county owned property which includes, but is not limited to:
