3. Unit prices will be guaranteed correct by the bidder.
4. Firm prices will be F.O.B. destination.
5. Purchases by MUSKOGEE County, Oklahoma, are not subject to state or federal taxes.
6. This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.
