1. Project Overview

Sligar Mechanical will provide all necessary labor, materials, and equipment to remove and replace the existing condenser coils on a Carrier chiller at the Muskogee County Detention Center facility. The replacement will ensure the continued efficient operation of the chiller system.

2. Scope of Work

2.1 Pre-Work Inspection and Preparation

- Conduct a site assessment to verify the existing conditions and confirm replacement procedures.
- Lock out and tag out the chiller system to ensure safety compliance.
- Recover all refrigerant from the system per EPA regulations.
- Disconnect and isolate electrical and mechanical connections to the existing condenser coil.

2.2 Coil Removal and Installation

- Furnish and install 2 new carrier microchannel condenser coils as needed (1 known major leak)
- Recover remaining refrigerant from leaking circuit
- Remove the defective condenser coil carefully to prevent damage to surrounding components.
- Inspect the system for any additional issues that may affect installation.
- Install the new OEM or approved equivalent Carrier condenser coil.
- Install 1 new filter drier
- Reconnect all electrical and mechanical connections.
- Replace any insulation, brackets, and support structures as necessary.
- Perform a pressure test to ensure there are no leaks in the system.
- Evacuate to or below 500 microns and recharge the system with recovered refrigerant and/or up to 60lbs of new R410A
- Verify proper operation of the chiller, including temperature control, pressure levels, and system efficiency.
- Take oil samples from each circuit to be sent for testing
- Add compressor oil to the circuit as needed
- Conduct a final inspection with the Muskogee County Sheriff's designated representative.


