Statement of Record

On the morning of February 10, 2021, the Road Foreman ordered Steve B. and Glen C. to go to Oktaha Town Hall to take the brush cutter off of the Kubota excavator. The Kubota was being parked at beside the Town Hall along with one of our motor graders. They removed the brush cutting head and put a bucket on the excavator to go dig a grave at Oktaha Community Cemetery. The funeral was postponed due to inclement weather so they left the excavator at the Oktaha Town Hall.

On February 19, 2021, Glen C. went to Oktaha to get the excavator and go to Oktaha Community Cemetery to dig the grave for the postponed funeral. After the funeral, the Kubota excavator was brought back to the County Barn in Muskogee.

Since the crew was not cutting brush for several months, no one verified that the cutter was still at Oktaha Town Hall. Once the crew was ready to begin cutting brush again, they went to Oktaha Town Hall to get the cutter but discovered it was missing (date unknown). The Road Foreman asked all other workers if they have seen, or moved the cutter. All yards and storage locations were checked but the cutter was never found.

The cutter is considered stolen and will be processed with the proper paperwork to remove from equipment inventory.
