Identify the need or risk

Hwy 69 to 64th Street West is one of the four most traveled east/west roads in District 3. The Castle is the top tourist attraction in Muskogee and sits on this road. The abundance of traffic has worn the road and shoulders to the point that two cars meeting have to slow down drastically to pass. We intend to raise and widen the road in this project which will allow for safer travel to the public and minimize flooding in two separate areas within this corridor. A 1.5 inch rain will normally result in two separate areas being two feet under water for a length of about 400 feet.

How does the proposed expenditure respond to the need or risk?

With drainage work that is being completed this week and the suggested overlay, we believe that much of the hazard will be alleviated. This road is also a major route that connects Hwy 69 and Hwy 16.



