Identify the need or risk

Ingress & Egress on S 65th St E is impaired during significant weather events. This causes hazardous conditions for school buses, emergency vehicles, and local traffic. It is subject to frequent flooding which has caused damage to the road making it dangerous for travel during significant weather events. Grade, ditchwork/drainage, and resurfacing has been done. Striping is needed to complete the project.

How does the proposed expenditure respond to the need or risk?

Dist. 2 has addressed drainage issues, put down 1 mile of a 2" asphalt overlay, and installed guardrails. Original expenditure wasn't enough to complete striping on the project. Striping will allow school buses, emergency vehicles, and local traffic to safely use the road.


