Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved all Purchase Orders. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved all monthly reports. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved Regular meeting Minutes for 04/11/2022. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

The Nation is prepared to pay a total of \$1,376,927.96 for construction and inspections upon receipt of invoice from Muskogee County. Once The Nation receives the invoice from Muskogee County, they (The Nation) will pay with Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) funding in accordance with their annual memorandum of agreement. In return, it's expected that Muskogee County pay the funds to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) which will effectively credit the County Improvements to Roads and Bridges account for Circuit Engineering District (CED) #2. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved for Bid #38, Mowing & Trimming around Mt View Fire Dept taken off the table. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved Bid #38, Mowing & Trimming around Mt View Fire Dept awarded to Ronnie LaCrone in the amount of \$450 per month. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved an Expenditure utilizing ARPA Funds for Muskogee County jail to Oklahoma Chiller in the amount of \$189,405.46. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved a Special Purchase Order for Haskell Fire Dept in the amount of \$60,745.44 to purchase a 2007 Pierce Quantum pumper truck with equipment included. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.
