Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, to open the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved all Purchase Orders. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved all monthly reports. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved Regular meeting Minutes for 9/6/2022. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously by Commissioner Payne.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved a Resolution to the ARPA Expenditure approved 9/6/2022 for Dist. 2. John Stout of Oktaha Volunteer Fire Dept. requested BOCC place a burn ban or advisory on the county due to the increased fire calls caused by excessive drought conditions and people burning. John stated there isn't enough volunteers to fight the number of fires in a timely manner.
