Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, to open the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved all Purchase Orders. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved all monthly reports. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved Regular meeting Minutes for 10/11/2022. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Payne, approved an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Muskogee for water and sewer improvements for a project at John T. Griffin Industrial Park. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved a Renewal Agreement with Community Care for employee medical benefits which increased 5% from last year. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved a new Community Care employee medical benefit plan which consists of a higher deductible. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Payne, approved a Renewal Agreement with Spark Services for Website Hosting, Domain Services and Office 365 user software. Under the renewal agreement, BOCC agrees to pay Spark Services an amount of \$222 monthly for web hosting, domain services and Office 365 software support with an additional \$6 per user of the software. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyslop and was made unanimously.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Hyslop, approved a Resolution to extend the Burn Ban for an additional 14 days. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously.
