Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Payne, approved a Letter of Commitment authorizing a nonbinding commitment between Muskogee County and EcoLink, a subsidiary of East Central Oklahoma electric cooperative, to bring high speed fiber broadband to Muskogee County and nearby areas effective 11/8/2021. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and was made unanimously by Commissioner Hyslop.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved a Declaration of Surplus from District 2. There is no supporting documentation with this motion and therefore the item is being placed on next weeks Agenda (11/15/2021). The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously by Commissioner Hyslop.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved the request from Muskogee Health Dept to utilize grant funds in the amount of \$18,025.97 to purchase a mobile satellite system

from Mobil Satellite Technologies. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously by Commissioner Hyslop.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Doke, approved a Right of Way Easement located on the east side of 114th Street and the north side of 133rd Street near Oktaha for a buried power cable and fiber from District 1 to YZY Capital Holdings, LLC. The motion was approved with the adherence to County Standards if needing to bore or cut country roads a separate application is needed. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne and was made unanimously by Commissioner Hyslop.

Vote: Motion was made by Commissioner Payne, approved the purchase of equipment off of state contract due to a savings of \$3,000. The purchase will be through Sourcewell at Kabota utilizing ARPA Funds in the amount of \$96,488.77. There is no supporting documentation with this motion. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Doke and was made unanimously by Commissioner Hyslop.
