1: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved to Open the meeting at 8:23 a.m. The motion was unanimous.

2: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved the Purchase Orders. The motion was unanimous.
