REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES

The Muskogee Board of County Commissioners met in session at 8:15 a.m. Members present were: Chairman, Keith Hyslop; Vice-Chairman, Kenny Payne; Member Ken Doke; and Muskogee County Clerk, Polly Irving.

1: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved to Open the meeting at 8:21 am. The motion was unanimous.

2: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved the Purchase Orders. The motion was unanimous.

3: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved the Monthly reports. The motion was unanimous.

4: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved Regular meeting minutes for May 18, 2026. The motion was unanimous.

5: No Action

No action was taken regarding a 2026-2027 Contract between Data Scout and the Assessor's Office for website GIS and Mapping Services.

6: Motion

Commissioner Payne made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Doke, approved a 2027 Solid Waste Request Form. **Commissioner Payne:** *"This is a program that yearly we're able to get grant monies to help clean up the county in different ways and there are OCCEDB approved and you have to have your request forms in by a certain date and this is just to take them through the meeting to say that we are going to request those funds."* The motion was unanimous.

7: Motion

Commissioner Payne made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Doke, approved a Declaration of Surplus 2026-15 for the Sheriff's Office regarding a 2018 Ford Explorer that is worn out and too expensive to fix and will be sold. The motion was unanimous.

8: No Action

No action was taken regarding Oklahoma Senate Bill No. 169 regarding State Employee Longevity.

9: Motion

Commissioner Doke made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Payne, approved the use of the Deductible Fund for repairs to a 2026 Chevy Tahoe Police Fleet for the Sheriff's Office. **Commissioner Payne:** *"The vehicle was on business in Claremore. A storm came through Claremore and hail destroyed half the cars in Claremore, to be honest with you. Our vehicle, which is the Sheriff's Department brand new Tahoe, sustained about \$15,000 worth of damage, which is repairable. And your plan is to repair that, correct?"* **Greg Martin:** *"Yes, we're going to do that."* **Commissioner Doke:** *"And you filed a claim with ACCO already?"* **Greg Martin:** *"Yes, I've already done that."* **Commissioner Doke:** *"So, I assume we haven't met our deductible, so we just need to..."* **Commissioner Payne:** *"Actually, I think this meets our deductible, this expenditure."* **Greg Martin:** *"We're going to keep the rest of it."* **Commissioner Doke:** *"So, looks like \$15,474.08 in damages. Deductible fund shows a balance of \$7,732.80 available to pay towards the claim. So, we'll need to provide authorization to use the remaining deductible fund"*

balance towards the claim for damages. And then, I guess, will they cover the difference? I think so, with actual coverage. Finally, our deductible almost this far from the end of the fiscal year.”
The motion was unanimous.
