 - Category I
 - Top 3% are identified through an aptitude test or nationally standardized test of ability.-no cap on how many students we have identified.
 - Category II
 - Multi-criteria -8% cap on your average daily attendance
 - Referral teachers, parents/guardians, peers, self
 - Achievement
 - Performance
 - Scales, inventories, checklist
 - Examples of Identification Areas creative arts (fine arts including band, choir, music, drama, theater), specific academic abilities, leadership (including sports, FFA, 4-H, state qualifying meets, debate, public speaking)
 - Assessments Used
 - KBIT2-Individual Assessments
 - Otis Lennon-OLSAT-Whole Grade Testing Grades 2 and 6
 - Who can qualify for services?
 - Students in grades KG-12th grade
 - Placements can be through recommendations or testing
 - The goal of the gifted program.
 - To provide a differentiated program which will give students the opportunity to develop a level of competency consistent with their aptitudes, goals, and interests; and to meet the needs of gifted students educationally, psychologically, and socially
 - Objective of the Gifted and Talented Program

- To foster skills of gifted/talented students in critical thinking, independent learning, problem finding/problem solving, creativity, specific academic abilities, and social interaction.
