ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

SECTION 2.08.020, "MEETINGS OF THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES", OF CHAPTER 2.08, "MAYOR AND TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES", OF TITLE 2, "ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL", OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF HASKELL; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HASKELL, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2.08.020:

That Section 2.08.020, "Meetings of the Town Board of Trustees", of Chapter 2.08, "Mayor and Town Board of Trustees", of Title 2, "Administration and Personnel", of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Haskell is hereby amended to recite in its entirety as follows:

<u>"2.08.020</u> Meetings of the Town Board of Trustees.

- A. The Board of Trustees shall meet regularly, on the first Tuesday of each month which is on or after the fifth day of that month, at six-thirty (6:30) p.m., and at such other times as it may prescribe by ordinance, resolution, or otherwise, at the municipal offices of the Town located at 1424 North Haskell Boulevard, Haskell, Oklahoma. In the event that the day for a meeting falls upon a day which is a legal holiday in the state, the meeting shall be held on the next succeeding Tuesday which is not a holiday or as otherwise set by the Board of Trustees. Special meetings may be called by the Mayor or any three Trustees. A majority of all the members of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum to do business, but a smaller number may adjourn from day to day.
- B. Every meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at the municipal offices of the Town unless, in case of an emergency, the Mayor designates another place in the Town for the holding of a special meeting. Any adjourned meeting may be held at any other place within the Town designated by the Board."

SECTION 2. REPEALER.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.

It being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Haskell, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof the Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
