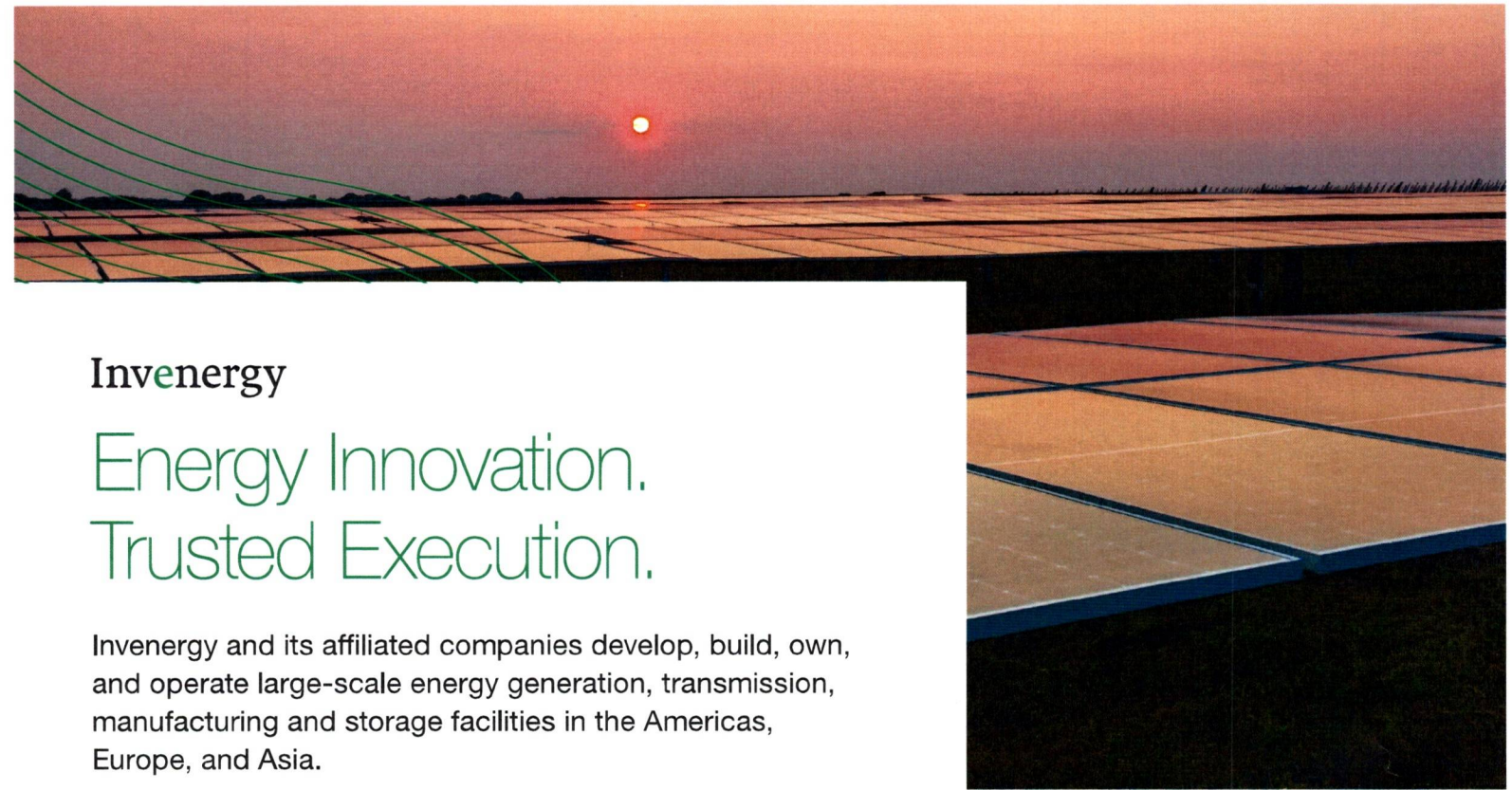

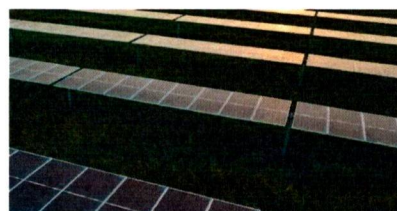
Commitment to Safe, Responsible Development

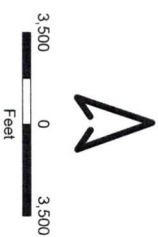
