This letter serves as formal written notice of a tort claim against Muskogee County pursuant to 51 O.S. § 156 of the Oklahoma Governmental Tort Claims Act.

2 Date Time and Location of Incident

On September 16, 2025, at approximately 2:00 p.m., I was present at the Muskogee County Courthouse located at 400 W. Broadway, Muskogee, Oklahoma 74401. The incident occurred on the second floor, in front of the door to the Judge Adair/Tucker chambers.

3 Description of the Incident

As I reached to open the door to the chambers, I slipped and fell on the wet floor in front of the door and in view of clients who were present. The floor was wet, and there were no warning signs, cones, notices, or other indicators stating that the floor was wet or warning visitors of the hazardous condition.

4 Injuries and Damages

As a direct result of the fall, I experienced cardiac symptoms, knee pain, rib pain, neck pain, and hip pain. Muskogee EMS was called to the scene, and I received medical treatment at Saint Francis Hospital Muskogee, including diagnostic imaging. The full extent of my injuries, medical expenses, and other associated damages may continue to develop.

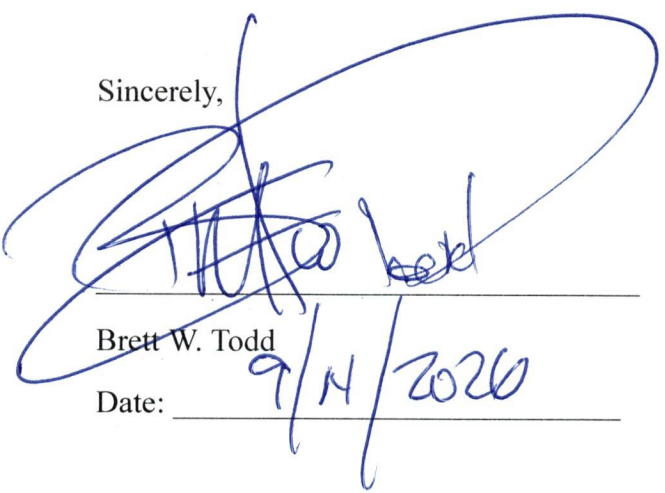
5 Amount of Claim

Pursuant to 51 O.S. § 156(D), the amount of compensation claimed for damages resulting from this incident is \$150,000.00. This amount represents medical expenses, pain and suffering, and other damages incurred as a result of the incident and is based on the information currently known to me.
