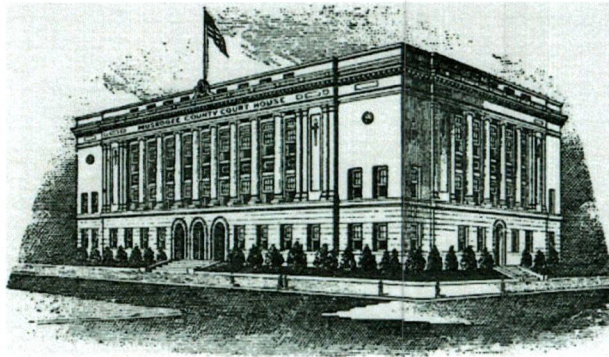

### RESOLUTION NO. 2024-07

**SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Purchase between District 3 and Wainwright Fire Department**

**WHEREAS**, the County Central Purchasing Act (19 OS § 1500 *et seq.*) describes the process the County government must use for the purchase of goods and services for the operation of the County government;

**WHEREAS**, 19 OS §§ 1501(A)(3)(h) provides the ordinary competitive bidding requirements do not apply when the County government purchases equipment from a political subdivision of this State whereby authorized by 19 OS § 421.1.

**WHEREAS**, 19 OS § 421.1 allows the County government to enter into agreements with any tribal governmental entity, any other county, or any other political subdivision of this State for the purpose of selling, transferring, trading, or otherwise disposing of equipment without regard for the original cost of the equipment at issue.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Wainwright, by and through its Fire Department, wishes to transfer certain equipment to the County government for the benefit of the County Commissioner District 3 and the County government, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, does hereby consent to the same upon the terms and conditions contained herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MUSKOGEE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. POLICY.** The County government shall obtain the following described equipment upon the terms and conditions contained herein:

**Equipment:** 2007 F350 Super Duty Laviat  
VIN #1FDWW37PEA76396

**Transferring Entity:** Town of Wainwright DBA Wainwright Fire Department  
**Acquiring Entity:** Board of County Commissioners FBO Commissioner District 3

Purchase Price: \$10,000.00

Fund: 1102-6-4300-4110 D.3 Capital Outlay

The aforementioned equipment shall be added to the County government's inventory records and continuously maintained thereon until otherwise lawfully disposed.

**SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION.** All departments, officers, and employees of the county government shall take all appropriate measures within their authority to implement this resolution. Nothing in this resolution shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect the authority granted by law to a county department or officer. This resolution shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations. This resolution is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the county, its departments, officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.

**SECTION 3. REPEALER.** All other resolutions and parts of other resolutions inconsistent or conflicting with any part of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

**SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision, paragraph, word, section of article of this resolution is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon execution and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.

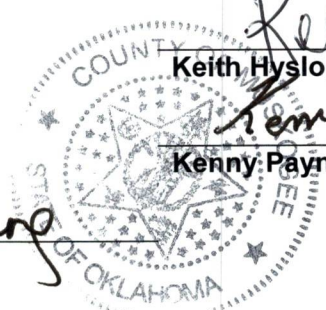
